

PRE-SEASON CHECKLIST

- Pick up sails from sailmaker**
- Start from the bottom**
 - Repaint bottom
 - Inspect keel and rudder
 - Inspect all joints and hydraulics
 - Inspect speed unit
 - Inspect trailing edge for proper shape
- Inventory and clean out excess items to reduce weight**
- Tune your rig**
 - Set rig to neutral position/1% mast rake
 - Head out in medium breeze to create a tuning guide
 - Adjust rig for every two knots of wind speed
 - Note headstay position
 - Note upper shroud position
 - Note lower shroud position
 - Note position of the backstay, vang, inhaul, leeds and the traveler as needed.
- Mark the moving parts:**
 - Halyards
 - Boom vang
 - Outhaul
 - Cunningham
 - Spinnaker sheets
 - Spinnaker guys
 - Jib/Genoa tracks
 - Main tracks
 - Sheets
 - Spinnaker pole uphaul and downhaul
 - Any other adjustable lines.
- Inventory**
 - All necessary safety equipment
 - Hand-bearing compass
 - Hand-held VHF
 - Navigation aids
 - Navigation aids paper backup
 - Starting countdown device
 - Wet notes pad
- Update apps**
 - Weather
 - Navigation
 - ISAF Rules/US Sailing Rules apps
- Finalize season schedule**
- Finalize team**
 - Order team apparel/gear
